NEIL SIMON'S RUMOURS ON STAGE

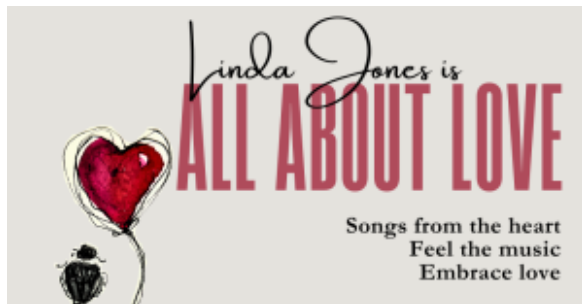
