HOW TO GET AROUND TOWN DURING THE EASTER HOLIDAYS



For the upcoming holidays, the Go Noosa Easter 2025 program will be running with the following public transport and parking initiatives:

BUS

- Free Easter Holiday Bus Service (5–21 April 2025) The 065 Go Noosa Loop will operate every 15 minutes between 7am and 7pm, and then every 30 minutes from 7pm to 10pm.
- All other buses (including 626, 627, 628, 631, 630 etc) will remain as 50 cents tap on tap off.

PARKING

- Parking Options The Noosa Heads Lions Park Paid Parking will be available (\$20/day).
- Alternatively, enjoy the Free Park & Ride at the AFL Grounds (Weyba Rd, Noosaville).




